ENGLISH

Reading:

Class Novel – Mrs Armitage on Wheels, Harvey Slumfenburger's Christmas Present. Guided reading -The Jolly Chriistmas Postman and Kipper's Christmas Eve

The children will be given opportunity to explore the language used when reporting the weather and will look at weather related vocabulary through talk and drama activities. Children will continue to develop reading comprehension and will sequence, retell and discuss Mrs Armitage on Wheels. The children will also look at poems with Bonfire theme. The children will work in groups to create their own poems about Bonfirenight. The children will explore the key features of a non chronological report.

The children will sequence a set of instructions for making hot chocolate before making their own. Some children will use pictures and as a challenge children will match the sentence to the picture before ordering them.

Writing Opportunities:

The children will continue to apply their phonological knowledge in their writing and include 'tricky' words.

Using our class novel the children will create story maps, write book reviews, write simple letters, sequence instructions and write a character description.

<u>Grammar:</u> The children will continue to practice using capital letters and full stops accurately.

They will practice joining worlds and clauses using 'and'

MATHS

During this half term we will continue with addition and subtraction. The children will use different resources and manipulatives to support them in solving one step problems. We will focus on their number bonds to 10 and inverse number sentences. The children will learn about fact families and how we can write number sentences in different ways.

The children will also look at 2D and 3D shapes; being able to recognise and name the shapes as well as discuss some of their properties.



SCIENCE — The children will observe changes across Autumn and Winter seasons and observe and describe weather associated with the seasons. We will look at the length of the day and how daylight hours change across the seasons. We will look at the terms hibernate and migrate and which animals hibernate and which migrate. The children will keep a weather diary for the week to compare how the weather and temperature can change. The children will have a go at presenting their own weather report to the class.

Vocabulary

ART & DT- Design technology:

This term we will be focusing on Drawing: Make your mark.

The children will begin to understand and use different line types and markmaking techniques in drawing; enhancing children's ability to describe lines, control drawing materials like pencils and chalk, and experiment with various media, while responding to music.

<u>MUSIC</u> The children will learn about how pulse, rhythm and pitch work together. The children will learn many new songs for our Christmas Nativity.

<u>PE – WLSSP</u> will deliver our PE sessions. The children will be focusing on fundamental skills. They will be introduced to skills needed in playing rugby. The children will be practicing their underarm and overarm throwing.

COMPUTING

This half term the children will use Purple Mash and the programmes 2paint and 2build. They will learn the skill in which to click and move the mouse at the same time. The children will participate in Online safety week.

RE

This half term the children will learn about the Christian Nativity Story of Christmas. The children will also look at different festivals and celebrations — comparing Christmas to Diwali and other festivals held by other religions at this time of year.

Jigsaw/PSHE

The children will look at celebrating differences between themselves and their peers and why it is good to be different and unique. They will learn about bullying and how to communicate with others as well as who to turn to if they are feeling sad or unsafe.
